5. Bids shall be accompanied by a 5% Bid Security and the successful bidder will be required to furnish Performance and Payment Bonds in accordance with the specifications. The Bid Security shall be made payable to the Indian Grave Drainage District.
6. Bidders are notified that not less than the prevailing wage rate as determined by the Illinois Department of Labor for the County of Adams shall be paid to all workmen, laborers, and mechanics performing work under this contract.
7. Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to accept other than the lowest bid, and to waive any irregularities or informalities in bids received.
8. The project requires the placement of a minimum of 62,000 cubic yards of sand material from one (1) Mississippi River dredge site to raise 1,840 linear feet of the levee and armoring the riverside of the levee with approximately 750 CY of riprap for approximately 50 linear feet at two (2) locations.

This project is sales tax exempt. The owner will issue an exemption certificate for the purchase or use of building materials, supplies, and equipment that will be used in the performance of the construction contract.
