**ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS**

The **Village of Gulfport** will receive Bids for **Henderson Pump Station Package No. 3** until **2:00 PM** local time on **June 5, 2018**, at **Klingner & Associates, PC, 610 N. 4<sup>th</sup> Street, Suite 100, Burlington, Iowa**, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Bids are invited upon the items and quantities of work as follows:

**Base Bid "A"**: Work consists of the construction of approximately 280 LF of 54" diameter steel storm water discharge pipe through the levee and ancillary structural steel supports and superstructure modifications to install one (1) owner supplied electric 48 inch 62,000 GPM drainage pump. Work also includes the installation miscellaneous electrical, mechanical, plumbing and operational systems and controls associated with the new pump in the existing control building as well as selective mechanical dredging, placement of riprap, concrete pad replacement, and miscellaneous site grading and levee restoration at the pump station based on specifications and plans.

**Base Bid "B"**: Work consists of disassembly, removal, inspection, refurbishment, reinstallation, and commissioning of the diesel engine, auxiliary power generator, direct-coupled right angle gear drive, universal joint power shaft and vertical pump in the existing 1995 Henderson Pump Station in an as-built configuration. The work also includes the replacement of the existing engine radiator, and peripheral equipment such as compressors, air piping and motorized air release valve.

A pre-bidding conference will be held on **May 16, 2018 at 10:00 a.m.**, at Klingner & Associates, PC, 610 N. 4<sup>th</sup> Street, Suite 100, Burlington, Iowa 52601.

Drawings, Project Manual, Addenda, and List of Plan Holders of Record will be available **starting Wednesday, May 9, 2018** through Quest CDN for a non-refundable \$10 download fee. A certified check or bank draft, payable to the order of **Village of Gulfport**, negotiable U.S. Government bonds (at par value) or a satisfactory Bid Bond executed by the Bidder and an acceptable surety in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total Bid shall be submitted with each Bid.

Attention is called to the fact that no less than the minimum salaries and wages as set forth in the Contract Documents must be paid on this project, and that the Contractor must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, color, religion, sex or national origin.

The **Village of Gulfport** reserves the right to reject any or all Bids or to waive any informality in the bidding.

Bids may be held by **Village of Gulfport** for a period not to exceed **45** days from the date of the opening of Bids for the purpose of reviewing the Bids and investigating the qualifications of Bidders, prior to awarding of the Contract.
