The Sny Island Levee Drainage District will receive Bids for **Pump System Equipment Procurement No. 1 & 3A** until **10:00 a.m.** local time on **July 26, 2018** at 616 N. 24th St., Quincy, IL 62301, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Lump sum bids are invited upon the items and quantities of work as follows:

The supply of storm water pumps for the purpose of providing additional storm water pumping capacity to be installed within the general vicinity of the existing Pump Station #1 and No. 3A. The supply of Right Angle Gear, Driveshaft, and supply of Diesel Engine – Pump Drive for each Station. The construction of ancillary pumping equipment and facilities and the installation of the pumps will be procured under separate contract.
