Each bid shall be made on a form furnished by the Engineer and shall be sealed in an envelope separate from the envelope containing the certified check or bid bond and shall be clearly marked as "BID ENCLOSED".

Drawings and specifications may be obtained at the Engineer's Office, Klingner & Associates, P.C., 616 North 24th St., Quincy, Illinois 62301, by depositing **\$25.00** in the form of a certified or personal check for each set of documents desired. Deposit will be returned when documents are returned in good condition within thirty (30) days of Bid Date.

4. For the purpose of providing additional information for bidders, a non-mandatory pre-bid conference for this project will be held Tuesday, October 23th, 2018 at 3:00 P.M. local prevailing time in the office of Klingner & Associates, P.C., 616 North 24th Street, Quincy, Illinois, 62301.
5. Bids shall be accompanied by a 5% Bid Security of Base Bid and the successful bidder will be required to furnish Performance and Payment Bonds in accordance with the specifications. The Bid Security shall be made payable to the Fabius River Drainage District.
6. Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to accept other than the lowest bid, and to waive any irregularities or informalities in bids received.
7. The project requires the placement of 14,000-16,000 tons rip rap on the riverside foreshore/shoreline of the levee from Station 164+50 to 175+50, and 26,000-30,000 tons of riprap along the riverside face of the levee from Station 152+50 to 180+00 up to an elevation of 490.8 feet (1912 datum). It shall be the CONTRACTOR'S responsibility to determine the actual amount of material to be placed to meet the project requirements. Estimated riprap quantities do not include bedding material or potential losses due to underwater placement. Base bid shall include all riprap along the Mississippi River Shoreline (station 164+50 to 175+50) and riprap along the riverside of the levee from Station 177+00 to 180+00. The remaining riprap shall be placed on the riverside slope of the levee from station 152+50 to 177+00, and shall be bid per linear foot of placed riprap. Bids will be evaluated based on the maximum riprap coverage that can be placed for the funds available for this project.

This project is sales tax exempt. The owner will issue an exemption certificate for the purchase or use of building materials, supplies, and equipment that will be used in the performance of the construction contract. Tax Exempt No. 37-1070315.
