The **CITY OF HANNIBAL, MISSOURI** will receive Bids for **HUCKLEBERRY PARK POND REHABILITATION** until **2:00 PM** local time on **May 3, 2019**, at **CITY HALL, 320 BROADWAY, HANNIBAL, MISSOURI 63401**, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Bids are invited upon the items and quantities of work as follows:

HUCKLEBERRY PARK POND REHABILITATION – Includes draining, excavation, riprap, grading, drainage piping, sidewalk, parking, and ADA accessible fishing dock.

A certified check or bank draft, payable to the order of City of Hannibal, Missouri negotiable U.S. Government bonds (at par value or a satisfactory Bid Bond executed by the Bidder and an acceptable surety in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total Bid shall be submitted with each Bid.

Attention is called to the fact that no less than the minimum salaries and wages as set forth in the Contract Documents must be paid on this project, and that the Contractor must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, color, religion, sex or national origin. Bidders for this work will be required to comply with the President's Executive Order Number 11246. Requirements for bidders and contractors under this order are explained in the specifications.

Bidders for this work will be required to comply with Executive Order 12549 (Debarment and Suspension). Requirements for bidders and contractors under this order are explained in the specifications.

All bidders are required to submit documentation of compliance with MBE/WBE requirements. These requirements are explained in the specifications.

Federal funds are being utilized in the project and all federal, state, and local requirements apply.

The **CITY OF HANNIBAL, MISSOURI** reserves the right to reject any or all Bids or to waive any informality in the bidding. Bids may be held by **CITY OF HANNIBAL, MISSOURI** for a period not to exceed 45 days from the date of the opening of Bids for the purpose of reviewing the Bids and investigating the qualifications of Bidders, prior to awarding of the Contract.
