Time and place of opening bids: Sealed proposals for **Bill Klingner Trail Extension, 5<sup>th</sup> Street to Parker Heights Park** in Quincy, Adams County, Illinois, described herein will be received at the office of the Quincy Park District, 1231 Bonansinga Drive, Quincy, Illinois 62301 until **10:00 am on August 8, 2019** and at that time publicly opened and read in the Park Board Room.

A Pre-Bid Conference will be held on July 18, 2019 at 10:00 a.m. local standard time at Klingner & Associates, P.C., 616 N. 24<sup>th</sup> Street, Quincy, IL.

Description of work: The work includes construction of a multi-use trail between 5<sup>th</sup> Street and Parker Heights Park. Major work components include grading, erosion control, asphalt & concrete pavements, bridge abutments, pre-engineered steel bridges, landscaping, signs, pavement marking and other miscellaneous work.

No bid may be withdrawn after the time for opening of the bids is past.
